Merit Promotion Announcements are open only to applicants who meet one of the following employment categories:

- Current Department of the Army permanent civilian employees
- Veterans with special recruitment authorities (See OPM Vet Guide at <http://www.opm.gov/StaffingPortal/vetguide.asp> for details)
- Certain spouses of military members who have transferred to a new location
- Current permanent Federal civilian employees or employees serving in other US Federal service positions covered by an existing interchange agreement approved by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM).
- Former Federal employees who have reinstatement eligibility
