- **Conserve Energy**
 - Turn off Computer Monitor at end of days work
 - Turn off lights when leaving vacated office/room space

SAVER CHECKLIST

- Turn off unnecessary lights
- Turn off computer or put in sleep mode
- Turn off copiers and faxes
- Turn off printers and copiers
- Adjust thermostat
- Unplug electrical drains
- Replace bulbs with CFLs
- Close desktop printer and windows
- Close drapes

ACT NOW TO SAVE

PULL THE PLUG ON ENERGY WASTE

SAVING IS SIMPLE

Computers and Monitors - Utilize sleep mode, turn power off to your monitor at night.

Government Vehicles - Do not idle for more than 30 seconds except to remove snow or ice.

Interior lights - Turn off lights in all unoccupied areas

Office equipment - Shall be Energy Star rated. Ensure sleep mode is enabled.

Heating and Air Conditioning - Heating season Occupied space setpoint 68F, Unoccupied setpoint 60F, Cooling season Occupied space setpoint 74F, Unoccupied setpoint 80F.

Outdoor Lighting - If not automatically controlled will be turned off during the day.

Vending Machines - All machines shall be de-lamped regardless of location.

Doors and Windows - When located between conditioned spaces and non-conditioned spaces shall not be propped open.

Light Bulbs - Replace incandescent with fluorescent or Energy Star rated bulbs. Purchase of incandescent bulbs is prohibited.

Personal Equipment - Remove all space heaters, refrigerators, microwaves, coffee pots. Personally owned appliances are prohibited.






