BRAC / BRAC-Related construction is providing:

- 56 new facilities; 24/56 (43%) completed
- 4 renovations; 2/4 completed
 - Bunker Hall (completed)
 - Building #1109 (completed)
 - Defense Contract Mgmt Agency (DCMA)
 - Building #2300

Construction Contracts:

- 14/39 (36%) BRAC/BRAC-Related completed
- 38/39 awarded
- 1/39 pending award:
 - Artifact Storage Facility (award Mar 11)

Programmed Funding: Over 98% awarded

Square Footage (SF):

- Building ~4.7M SF of facilities with BRAC
- Completed over 2.4M/4.7M SF (~53%)







1. **Coordinate, synchronize, and execute BRAC requirements and related impacts/effects**





Seasonal Flu Vaccination



- Flu disease is reported at minimal (22 Oct 10)
- Primary goal of the DoD Influenza Vaccine Immunization Program is to protect all Active Duty, National Guard and Reserve personnel, mission-essential Department of the Army Civilians, healthcare personnel, and TRICARE beneficiaries
- Target immunization: 90% of Active Duty, National Guard, and Reserve personnel by 1 December 2010.
- **2010-2011 flu vaccination** will protect against 2009 H1N1, and two other influenza viruses (an H3N2 virus and an influenza B virus)
- All 6 months and older are advised to get vaccinated
- Fort Lee (Compo 1, 2, 3): 47% (of 8112) per MEDPROS on 22 Oct 10

OCONUS THREAT ISSUES & HOLIDAY SECURITY RECOMMENDATIONS

- French, German and British security services uncovered operational plans by al Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP) to attack European mass transit & hotels – targeting French facilities confirmed by Saudi Intelligence
- AQAP is also behind the recent attempts to blow up aircraft with explosives
- Security Recommendations for the Holidays:
 - Remain alert while using mass transit, staying in large hotels in major cities, or while attending large events, such as the Times Square New Years Eve Celebration , College Bowl Games or the Super Bowl.
 - The Crime Threat for Mexico is HIGH. Three Americans were killed 1 Nov 10.
 - CDR USNORTHCOM Travel Directive 10-003: “ALL ROUTINE NON-OFFICIAL TRAVEL (LEAVE & PASS) REMAINS PROHIBITED TO THE STATES OF CHIHUAHUA, COAHILA, SINALOA, DURANGO, NUEVO LEON, TAMAULIPAS, MICHOACAN AND THE CITY OF NOGALES. OFFICIAL DOD TRAVEL TO THESE AREAS IS LIMITED TO MISSION ESSENTIAL TRAVEL ONLY.”

Noncompetitive Appointments for Certain Military Spouses



Executive Order 13473

Who is Eligible for this Authority?

- Spouse of a Service Member serving on active duty when they receive orders to relocate; or
- Spouse of Service Member whose disability resulted from active duty in the armed forces; or
- Un-remarried widow or widower of a Service Member who was killed while on active duty in the armed forces, it does not have to be combat related.
- Must relocate with the Service Member to the new permanent duty station.
- Must be within the geographic area of the permanent duty station;



Executive Order 12721

Who is Eligible for this Authority?

- Family Members who have completed 52 weeks of service (NAF/AF) under a local hire appointment(s) overseas.
- Work must be performed during the time the family member was accompanying a sponsor officially assigned to an overseas area.
- Must have received a fully successful or better (or equivalent) performance rating
- A Family member is a spouse or unmarried child under the age of 23


