Fort Lee Invites Public to Celebrate Army Birthday

Fort Lee will celebrate the Army's 237th birthday during a special June 14 event at the north entrance of the Combined Arms Support Command headquarters (adjacent to Seay Field). The festivities will include music by the 392nd Army Band, a variety of Army displays, a Bronze Star presentation and a cake-cutting ceremony featuring the oldest and youngest Soldiers on post.

All are welcome to this Family friendly celebration, including the general public. Starting at 2 p.m., visitors can view a variety of exhibits and displays featuring the Association of the United States Army, the U.S. Army Women's Museum, the Quartermaster Museum, Kenner Army Health Clinic and the Family and MWR Directorate.

At 3 p.m., the official ceremony begins. It features a mass reenlistment with 20 Soldiers renewing their service commitment to the Army.
