#### Public Meeting Scheduled for LSP Update

On February 27, Fort Lee held a public meeting on the Army's Institutional Training Travel Policy (ITDLMP), which governs how Army students are housed and fed while in a temporary duty (TDY) status. ITDLMP pays actual lodging costs through Army centralized billing and mandates that Soldiers attending The Army Service School (TASS) and Army Logistics University stay on post in Army Lodging or off post in contracted hotels that are part of the Lodging Success Program (LSP).

ITDLMP does not apply to Soldiers attending training at their home station in a permanent duty status, enlisted Soldiers attending their Initial Military Training (BCT, AIT, OSUT), taking contingency operation courses, attending training in a permanent change-of-station status, or those from the Individual Ready Reserve. Nor does it impact civilians or members of the other service branches attending training on post.

During the February meeting, questions were raised about the LSP and the process and requirements for selection to the program. Some of the questions required further research and consideration, and we'd like to share the outcome and answer any additional questions.

The LSP update meeting is open to the public and announcements will be sent to those who attended the first meeting.
