### Fourth at the Fort Includes Music, KidZone, Fireworks

Featuring entertainment by local singing group En'Novation and Fort Lee's 392nd Army Band, as well as a kid-zone play area and a fireworks display, this year's Fourth at the Fort celebration promises a heaping helping of fun for the whole family.

The event is scheduled for 5-10 p.m. July 4 at Williams Stadium. Admission is free and open to the public. Lee Avenue gate will be open to all traffic from 3-11:30 p.m. A Avenue gate also will remain open until 11:30 p.m. to accommodate the event.



Personal pyrotechnics, tailgating, glass bottles, smoking and pets are not permitted in or around the event area. Coolers may be no larger than 6-by-6-by-12 inches. Food and beverage vendors will be on site.

A valid state- or government-issued identification card with photo is required for anyone 18 years of age or older to access the installation. Motorists are asked also to watch for pedestrians while entering and exiting the event.

### Army invites public to comment on impacts of possible force reductions

The Department of the Army has completed a Supplemental Programmatic Environmental Assessment for Army 2020 force structure realignment, which analyzes the impacts of potential personnel reductions at Fort Lee and 29 other military installations. The SPEA and a draft Finding of No Significant Impact are now available for public comment in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act.

All interested members of the local community are invited to review the document and provide comment. The draft FNSI, which includes the details of the environmental assessment, or SPEA, may be accessed at [www.aec.army.mil/Services/Support/NEPA/Documents.aspx](http://www.aec.army.mil/Services/Support/NEPA/Documents.aspx). Copies of the draft report also will be available at the Fort Lee Community Library, Colonial Heights Public Library, Hopewell Regional Library, Prince George Public Library, and the William R. McKenney and Rodof Sholom Branches of the Petersburg Public Library.

Comments will be accepted until Aug. 25. While no significant environmental impacts were identified from the proposed action, there would be socio-economic impacts at most affected military installations. The draft FNSI concludes that preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

Fort Lee was assessed on a loss of up to 3,600 Soldiers and civilian employees. That figure includes 879 reductions that already occurred with the realignment of units and personnel associated with the now-inactivated 49th Quartermaster Group. [Read More.](#)
