Providing Soldiers and Family members information on retirement programs, benefits and entitlements.

It is imperative that Soldiers and their families plan their path out of the military service long before the application for retirement is submitted. Not having a post-military-career plan, in many cases, results in a less-than-happy retirement.

At least **12-24 months** before a planned retirement, a Soldier and his or her spouse should attend a pre-retirement orientation provided by the Installation Retirement Services Officer. There is no prohibition to attending a session long before a retirement application is submitted and another shortly before an actual retirement date. The information provided is designed to help Soldiers and Families prepare for retirement.

Keep in mind, “Retirement is a process NOT an event!”
